We look forward to meeting with you and will have copies of our map and Insurance Coverage with us.

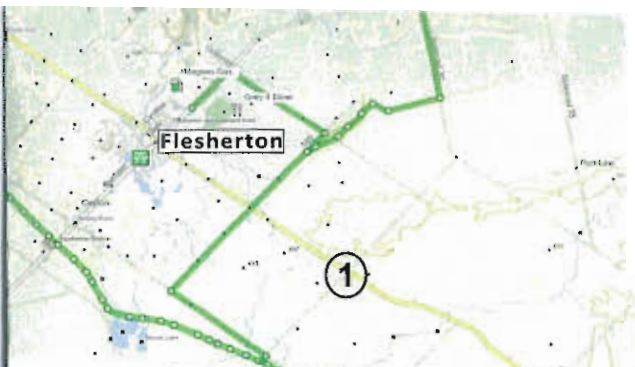

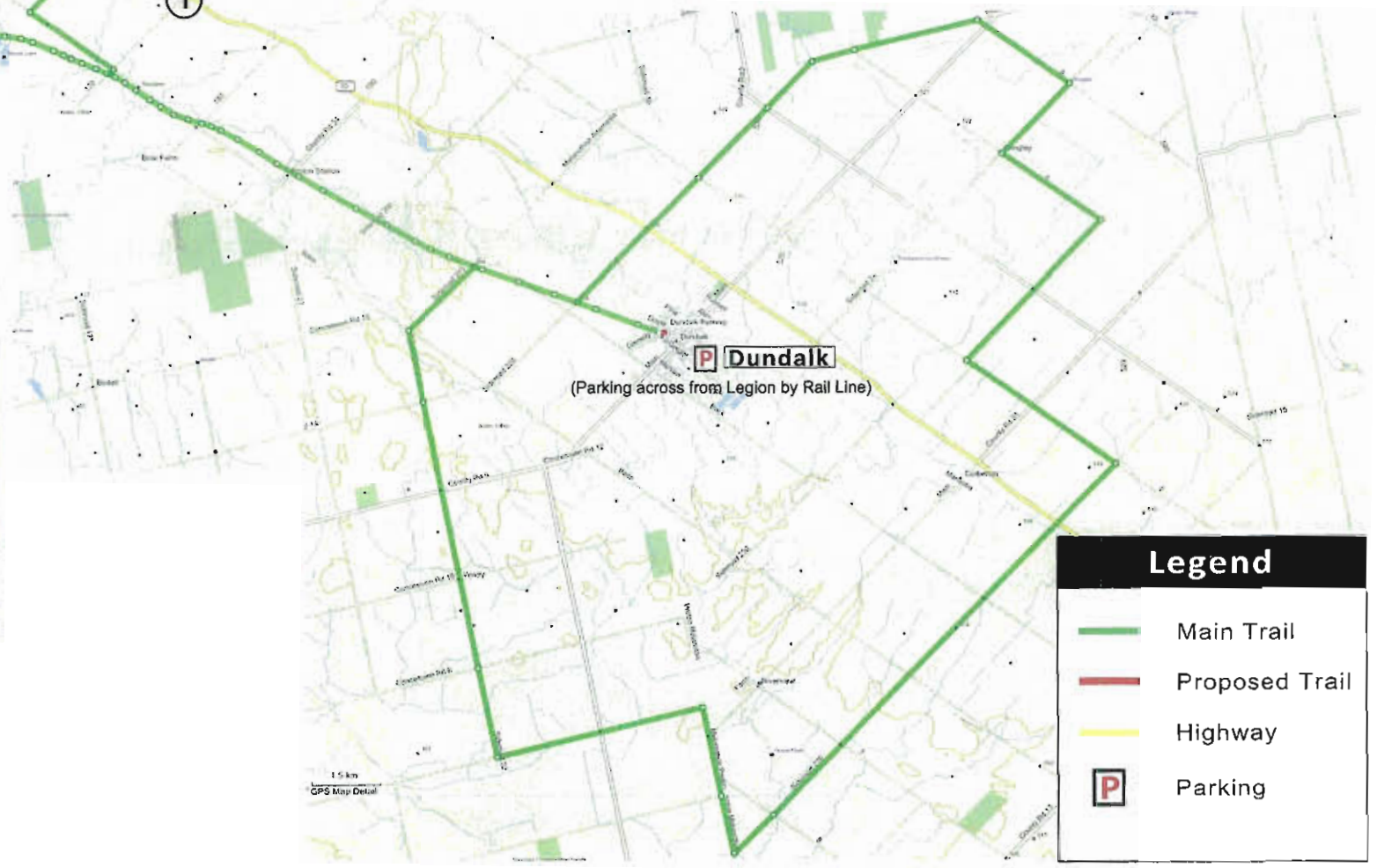
